## **Symptom**

You have implemented the Badl ORDER SAVE but it doesn't work in Web UI even though the method CHECK BEFORE SAVE raised a DO\_NOT\_SAVE exception.

### **Environment**

- SAP Customer Relationship Management 7.0 or above
- SAP CRM Web Client User Interface (Web UI)

# Reproducing the Issue

- 1. Logon to Web UI using the relevant business role, i.e. SALESPRO.
- 2. Create the business transaction for what the Badl is relevant.
- Complete all the data.
- 4. Save the document.
- 5. The document is saved event though an error is raised.

#### Cause

- Wrong implementation of the Badl ORDER\_SAVE.
- In the method IF\_EX\_ORDER\_SAVE~CHECK\_BEFORE\_SAVE, the BOL layer is called.
- It is a violation of the layering of the application.

### Resolution

- 1. Double-check the Badl implementation to avoid calls to BOL layer.
- Please turn on checkpoint group GENIL\_GENERAL\_CHECKS in transaction SAAB.
- You will see a reset is called from the Badl.
